- ◆ **Complete the Red Rock Action Plan's 36-mile connected trail loop** around the greater Birmingham metro, boosting the Red Rock Trail System® to over 200 walkable and bikeable miles in Jefferson County.
- ◆ **Open six new publicly accessible properties** across our region, doubling our existing ones and creating more landmark spaces facilitated by FLT such as Red Mountain Park and Turkey Creek Nature Preserve.

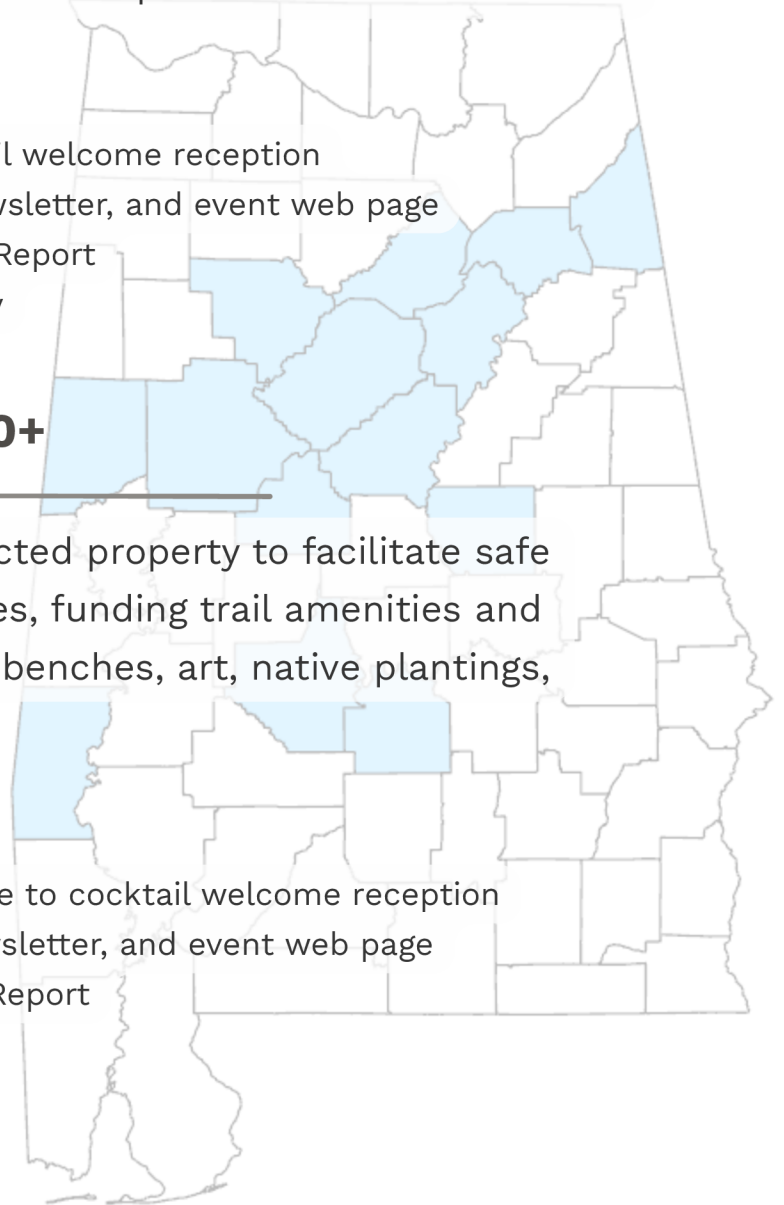
